## SBU shuts down tennis teams

Sophomore Maggi Schutte was relieved after the Bulldogs' 9-0 win against Lincoln University on Wednesday and said it provided a big confidence boost after a tough weekend.

"We've faced a lot of tough teams lately," Schutte said. "[Wednesday] was a great match to get some wins in and our confidence back before heading into another full weekend."

The Bulldogs headed into the match against Lincoln following a dismal weekend where they lost 9-0 to Southwest Baptist University on Saturday and 7-2 to Rockhurst on Sunday.

The team was running on all cylinders, sweeping the Blue Tigers in both doubles and singles, two of which were by forfeit. In singles,

both Schutte and senior Kelsey Kuykendall won their matches 6-0, 6-0, while sophomore Lauren Higgins won her match 6-1, 6-0.

The Bulldogs had a tough Saturday against the SBU Bearcats. Sophomore Jennifer Hawkins lost her match in a tiebreaker (2-6, 6-3, 10-4), and that proved to be the closest match of the day.

Sunday, Truman had another losing day against the Rockhurst University Hawks, but not without a few wins.

In singles, junior Ellen Russell (7-5, 6-2) won her match while junior Dagmar Velez won her match in a tiebreaker.

In doubles, the pairing of Schutte and Higgins lost a close match 8-6.

The men lost 9-0 to the Southwest Baptist University Bearcats and 8-1 to the Rockhurst University Hawks this weekend to bring their

record to 0-6. Head coach Pete Kendall said he anticipated difficulty going into the match.

"We knew we'd have our hands full and, as it turns out, we did," Kendall said. "It probably turned out about as expected. I thought we might win a couple of matches, but we didn't. The guys played some really good doubles. They didn't get any wins, but I was pleased with that."

The Bulldogs faced the Bearcats and had a chance to take an early lead in doubles play Saturday. The number one doubles team of juniors Eric McCullough and Mark Sturley lost 8-1. The pairing of freshmen Kirk Schlueter and Adam King and the pairing of sophomore Jon Gooch and freshman Joe Murphy-Baum both fell 9-7 to start off the day for the Bulldogs.

In singles, the Bulldogs lost all six of their matches with the closest match being Murphy-Baum who lost 7-6, 6-0.

Sunday, the men faced Rockhurst with a similar result.

The only win of the weekend for Truman came from the pairing of Schlueter and King, who won their match 9-8 (9-7). McCullough and Sturley lost their match 8-3 while Gooch and Murphy-Baum lost 8-2.

In singles, the Bulldogs again lost all of their matches. Notable matches include McCullough who lost 7-5, 6-3 and Murphy-Baum who lost 6-2, 6-4.

The Bulldogs' next action is Friday as they travel to Emporia State. Saturday, the Bulldogs will travel to Washburn before coming back to Kirksville to face the University of Missouri-St. Louis Tritons at 11 a.m.

Lorensen had a variety of responsibilities with UNO including scouting, exchanging film, setting up travel schedules, helping at summer camps and recruiting prospective players.



Junior Ryan Trimble won his second award in three weeks after throwing a complete game one-hitter last weekend against Southwest Baptist University. It was the second shutout for Trimble this season.

He hasn't allowed an earned run in his last 29.2 innings. Trimble leads the MIAA in ERA and opponent's batting average. He has given up the second fewest earned runs in the conference.
